

Breakout Session Class Descriptions

101: Missions Behind the Walls: This session will teach the basic plan Jesus gave his church for reaching the incarcerated. Additionally you will receive tools that will guide you in the process of engaging behind the walls with the good news and how the church can minister to those who are incarcerated as well as minister to the families of those who are incarcerated. **Instructor: Rev. Dr. Harold Trulear**

102: The Local Missions: This session is designed to show how churches can become centers of mission vision and implementation, accomplishing God's design for the local church. Attendees will be empowered with practical "how-to" steps for developing fully-functioning local mission ministries. Topics covered will include; setting local mission priorities, establishing guidelines for lay leaders, networking in the community and setting measurable metrics. **Instructor: Rev. James Victor**

103: Domestic Missions (Youth Ages 11-18): This session is designed to gain valuable insight on how to help student leaders develop a successful and comprehensive approach to youth missions in your church. Conversation will include examples of youth mission activities, as well as information about how to decide which pieces will best fit within your church and youth ministry. 104: Global Missions - Your Way or God's Way: This session is designed to encourage people and congregations to feel equipped to "Bring the Good News." Participants will review short-term mission trips in three movements: preparation, do's and don'ts, and integration of the mission experience once missionaries have returned home. **Instructor: Rev. 105: Sponsorship by Grants: This session is designed to aid in developing and understanding grant proposals for faith-based organizations. Topics include preparing and prospecting for grant proposals; and understanding the components of the proposal requirements. 106: Open Children's Hearts to Others' Needs (Ages 3-7 & 8-10): Children will learn ways they can become actively involved in missions by giving of themselves and praying for others: missionaries, their families and people all around the world. **Instructors: Deaconess Liz Williams and Sister Theatrice Stone (Children 3-7); Sister Wanda Little (Children 8-10)**
